COVID-19 POLICIES

Like every synagogue throughout the country, we have struggled with how to celebrate these High Holy Days in a way that brings us together in comfortable, inclusive, and meaningful worship, while fulfilling our Jewish obligation to care for the health of our community above all else. These concerns led to the important decision that **all in-person High Holy Day gatherings will be held outdoors**. Additional guidelines are below.

Shofar Kids and Family Services

- Masks are required for all adults and children over the age of two for these services, regardless of vaccination status.

Main Services

- Masks are strongly encouraged for all unvaccinated adults and children.
- Vaccinated attendees may choose whether or not to wear a mask, according to their own comfort.
- Please note: social distancing may not be possible when seated for services.

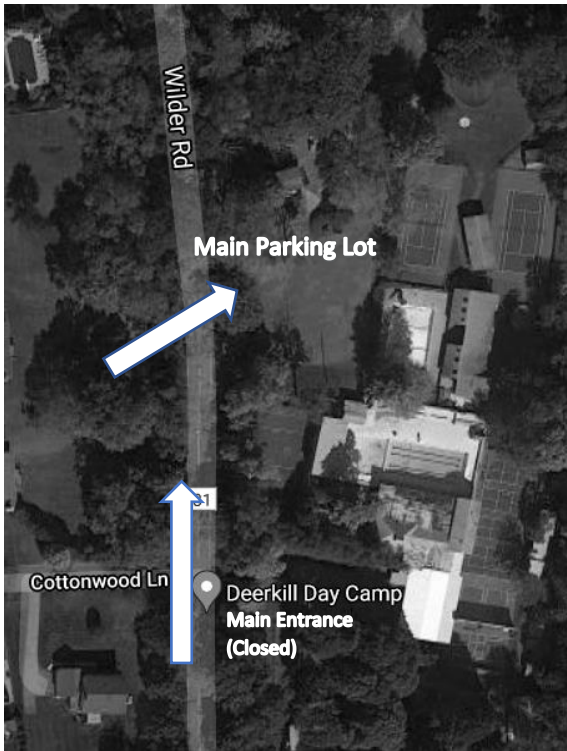
Additional Details

- Extra masks will be available on-site for anyone who needs one.
- Any person with a known Covid-19 exposure or who is experiencing symptoms of illness should not attend services in person. The livestreaming option will be available to all.

PARKING INFORMATION



1. **Main Parking Lot** - Drive past the main entrance of Deerkill Day Camp (the GPS destination). Enter at the next entrance on the right, and you will be directed to a parking spot. Please see map.

2. **Accessible (handicapped) parking** is available for those who require it. Please speak to an usher when you arrive at the parking lot.

3. **Carpooling** - Parking is limited. Please carpool and arrive at camp in as few cars as possible!

4. **Arrival** - Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before the service begins. This will help with our traffic flow and ensure enough parking for everyone.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

WEATHER

- Our outdoor services will be held rain or shine. In case of inclement weather, please be prepared to walk a short distance from the parking lot to the covered pavilion for services.

SEATING

- We will be using metal folding chairs for seating during services. Please feel free to bring a cushion or small pillow with you.

CLOTHING

- Because our High Holy Day services will be outdoors, we welcome you to dress for the weather and attend in clothing you find comfortable and suitable for the day.

RESTROOMS

- Restrooms—including accessible restrooms—will be available on site. Ushers will direct you to the nearest restroom.
